#### **HUMPHREY PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

Humphrey Public Schools is a state accredited Nebraska school district. The high school is a class "D1" school and participates in the activities of the Nebraska School Activities Association. A PK-12 school is operated in Humphrey while a Kindergarten, Special Education and Title I center is operated in Lindsay, NE. Special Education and Title I services are also provided to qualifying students at Humphrey St. Francis. Humphrey Public also provides early childhood special education services across the district to qualifying students.

The school district covers roughly 163.8 square miles and had a total enrollment of 306 students on October 14, 2022, which is the beginning of the second quarter, which includes 12 students enrolled in Kindergarten at the Lindsay Attendance Center.

Humphrey Public School officially became a member of the East Husker Conference in 2012-2013.

- 80% of students 7-12 will score in the average range or above in Geometry, specifically in the area of measurement.

- All PK students will increase letter and sound accuracy.
- All K-1 students will increase fluency scores on Acadience testing.
- All 2-6 students will meet or increase their MAP Reading RIT score in the areas of building vocabulary/characteristics and analysis of informational text.
- 80% of students 7-12 will score in the average range or higher in the area of analyzing theme, specifically drawing conclusions, inference, prediction, and analyzing, in informational and literary text as measured by MAP test results.
- 80% of students 7-12 will score in the average range or higher in the area of characteristics of text, specifically author's purpose and perspective, in informational and literary text as measured by MAP test results.
