The May Financial report was reviewed by the Board.

Ron Krings, Head Maintenance/Custodial gave his report. Ron updated the Board on the possible replacement of the current fire alarm panel systems. The Board decided to go with Electronic Systems to upgrade with a new system to include the entire school including mechanical rooms and kitchen. Electronic Systems has a two-year inspection warranty. Their quote was \$32,519.88. Electronic Systems will begin installing the new system on June 15, and will be completed by August 1.

Brice King, Principal gave his report. Summer letters and information has been sent out to students and their families. We have asked parents to let us know by Monday, June 8, if their child will be attending summer school. As of now, we have about 23 students attending. Additional details pertaining to grouping, social distancing, and proper cleaning procedures were sent along with the information letter so parents could make an informed decision on attending. We will continue to follow the directed health measures through the East Central Health District. Our end of year in-service PK-12 staff attended in person or via Zoom. Items discussed were the different possibilities for a remote environment, and the resources available. The staff was informed that our online learning platform would be Google Classroom PK-12 next year. This would be utilized whether we are in the building or virtually. Staff were encouraged to take part in the professional development opportunities provided by ESU 7 over the summer. Mr. King discussed with the board the Reading Improvement Act that Legislature passed in 2018. Due to COVID-19, a third benchmark assessment was not given. NDE informed us to use the winter benchmark assessment for summer reading offerings. We had 10 students qualify for summer services. Theses student were encouraged to attend the Summer School program and were also offered additional online resources to utilize at home. Mr. King will have the handbook updates and changes completed and ready for the July board meeting.

Greg Sjuts, Superintendent gave his report. We have set Saturday, August 1, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. as our scheduled date and time for graduation regardless if we are in a normal environment or modified environment. Our plan for graduation must be approved by the East Central Health District. The State Legislature is currently shut down but the Speaker Jim Scheer recently set a target date of July 20 for reconvening to finish the session. Mr. Sjuts is serving on one of the NRCSA's Statewide Superintendents Re-opening Committees which is the transportation group. They meet once a week. Over 100 Superintendents and ESU Administrators have committed to helping develop ideas for use in developing a school district's re-opening plan for the coming school year. There are eight sub-committees, and each are tackling a different topic that needs to be addressed in considering re-opening. The goal is to have a 'finished' document by the first weekend in July. Once each of the committees complete their document, they will be released to schools via email. Humphrey Public School has released "Phase 1" on Wednesday May 27, and that started on Monday, June 8, 2020 and includes Weight Room Facilities Guidance. On Friday, June 5, 2020, Humphrey Public School released to all parents "Phase 2" and that begins on Monday, June 15, 2020 and includes Driver's Education, Summer School Flex Funding, Extended School Year SPED services and FFA services. Mr. Sjuts and Mr. King have interviewed two applicants for the Family Consumer Science position, and are not able to recommend a candidate for our students and school. We will continue to advertise on the Teach in Nebraska website. The Close-up group will be traveling in June 6 – June 13 2021 to Washington DC/New York

There was no School Improvement Committee meeting held due to the COVID-19 school closure.
