## JAMES KEOGH

The Annual Staff of 1968 wishes to dedicate this Bulldog Yearbook to Mr. James Keogh, a native of Humphrey and a 1932 graduate of Humphrey Public School.

James Keogh was born on a Platte County farm on October 29, 1916. He first attended a one-room school in District 42 southwest of Cornlea. Later he attended Humphrey Public School where he began his career by editing the school paper in his senior year. In July of 1938 he started writing for the OMAHA WORLD HERALD, where he was named city editor in 1948. He became connected with Time Magazine as a part-time correspondent from 1944 to 1951. In 1951 he joined the staff as a writer in the national affairs department and later edited most of the magazine's departments. He was appointed Senior Editor in 1956 and Assistant Managing Editor in April of 1961. On May 13, 1968, he was appointed Executive Editor of the magazine and now holds a title which has not appeared on the magazine's masthead for several years.

We believe that Mr. Keogh represents a source of inspiration for all small-town boys and girls to apply their talents in the proper channels and then work diligently so that they, too, may one day achieve the type of success that he so clearly illustrates. Mr. Keogh has our congratulations and sincere wishes for continued success in his chosen field.
