From the Superintendent's desk:

Welcome back to all staff and students for the 2022-2023 school year! I hope you had a relaxing, fun filled, and enjoyable summer. The administrative team is ecstatic to begin another school year. This year's teacher in-service will be held on Tuesday, August 9 and Wednesday, August 10. The first day of school for students is Thursday, August 11, which will be a 1:00 p.m. early dismissal. I have included some reminders in my newsletter that will hopefully assist you as we get closer to the first day of school.

On Thursday, August 4, at 7:00 p.m., Humphrey Public will host a 7th grade orientation forstudents and parents to help prepare students for their first day of school. Ms. Oelsligle and Mr. Kirby will host the event. If you have questions regarding 7th grade orientation, please contact the school office or Mr. Kirby by email.

On Tuesday, August 2 and Thursday, August 4, Humphrey Public will be running their Tech. Bootcamp and the ImPact testing for students in grades 7-12. Hours for Tuesday will be 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Thursday will be 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. There was a Connect 5 message sent out with this information as well. Students and parents will be able to sign forms, pay fees, review expectations of proper technology uses, as well as digital citizenship reminders. Along with the Tech. Bootcamp, ImPact testing will be taking place while the students are in the building. This will be for students participating in athletics. There is no cost to the parents for their students to take this test. The data collected is used as a baseline for medical personnel should a concussion occur.

Humphrey Public School will be competing in all athletic events with Lindsay Holy Family for grades 7-12, as well as the grades 9-12 softball cooperative with both Lindsay HF and Twin River. We work very hard in making our communications clear to keep parents and student-athletes informed on practice locations, leave times and game times. Mrs. Hanzel will continue to utilize the Google Doc call HLHF Bulldog Activities Schedule, which can be found on our school website under the quick links. We will also do our best to quickly notify parents if there are schedule changes utilizing social media and our Connect 5 system. If you ever have any questions or concerns regarding the calendar, please contact the school office for clarification.

With the start of a new school around the corner, I would like to introduce our new staff members. I want to welcome Josh Rathje who will be our new elementary principal, Shelby Zach who will be our new kindergarten teacher, Robby Heesacker and Geri Bender who will be serving our school as custodians, Terry Wemhoff who will be one of our kitchen assistants, and

Jessica Bender who will be serving as a paraprofessional. I want to welcome them all to our family and team here at Humphrey Public School.

Once again you will find all the handbooks on our school website. You can access the handbook by clicking on the Parent Connection tab. As you are navigating our website and there is something not on there that you would like added, please let us know and we will do our best to have it added to our website to make it easier to find and access information.

The Free and Reduced Breakfast/Lunch forms will be sent home the first day of school and are also on the school website. I encourage all parents to fill this form out because should your family qualify for a free/reduced price meal, the school district also receives funding based on our free and reduced number of children. This federal program helps fund academic assistance known as Title I for our school. We also receive federal and state reimbursement for every reduced or free meal which helps our school breakfast and lunch program. Please know the free and reduced information is kept confidential and is known by only Michelle Wemoff and Mr. Rathje. The USDA has informed schools that those who qualify for free or reduced meal prices will be lumped into one category, receiving free meals. It is imperative that you take the time to fill out this form. There will be additional forms in the packet that is sent home. We greatly appreciate getting those forms filled out and turned back into the office as soon as possible.

I am very excited to begin my seventh year at Humphrey Public School and first year as superintendent. I look forward to serving the district to the best of my abilities. Humphrey has been a phenomenal place to be and I look forward to being here for years to come. I will continue to do my very best to model the importance of respect for self and others, promote Bulldog pride in our school, provide a safe and productive environment and provide educational opportunities for our students and staff. #### August 2022

I think just about every year we all say that the summer break was short. Hopefully, everyone was able to get out and enjoy the summer with family and friends. The start of the 2022-2023 school year is just around the corner and administration and staff are excited to see students in the building once again.

As the year starts there are a few things that I wanted to address so that we can get started on the right foot.

- The USDA has indicated that the school lunch program will go back to prepandemic routine. What that means is school lunches will NOT be paid for by the government and will be the responsibility of the student/parent. However, please take the time to fill out a Free and Reduced lunch application that will be in the back to school packets given out on the first day of school as you may qualify for this program.
  - Under federal law students are not allowed to have food that is wrapped in commercial packaging (i.e. McDonald's, Subway, and Canes)
- Please take the time to review the Student/Parent handbook for this academic year. There are a few minor changes. 1. Students who are ineligible are able to become eligible right away if their grades are brought up (with my approval). 2. I will send out a warning list for the D/F list every Friday (via Connect5) to parents. The D/F list will be released every Monday. 3. Cell phones are to be placed in the student's lockers. 4. Water bottles will need to be clear or have a clear lid.
- As activities begin, if you would like to allow your student to go to a school activity to watch, such as football, volleyball, cross country, and softball. Please complete the following. 1. Call the office to allow your student to be released for that activity. I ask that you do this at least a day before the event. 2. Have your student complete a yellow release form by the teachers so that any class work is understood. I am asking the students to complete these steps to eliminate any confusion in the office, classroom, and cafeteria. Please do not call the day of the activity to have your student released to go watch a meet. Please plan ahead of time.
- Please contact Mrs. Luedtke about PowerSchool.

Please welcome Mr. Rathje and Ms. Zack to the building. Mr. Rathje will be the new PK-6 principal and comes from Fullerton. Ms. Zack will be the new kindergarten teacher and comes from Columbus.


