Humphrey Public School 2020-2021 2nd Semester Winter Season COVID-19 Protocols Humphrey-Lindsay Holy Family Activities (1-4-2021)



All protocols have been developed using current directed health measures (DHM) and NSAA mandates and guidelines. The following are expectations at Humphrey-Lindsay Holy Family home events. When we visit other schools, they may have different guidelines. HLHF teams, coaches, and fans are expected to comply with those expectations. All protocols are subject to change. Please check for updates as the season progresses. Please be respectful of the MASK mandate covering both your nose and mouth to help prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Capacity/Occupancy

- Fan attendance for all indoor extracurricular activities is limited to a predetermined passlist based on our 50% capacity, which is 242 people.
- The current DHM requires capacity to be capped at 50%. Three (3) tickets per player/coach listed on the roster for HLHF when we have 4 games for all fans. Two (2) tickets per roster player/coach for the visiting team. Student managers will be limited to three per team and will receive one ticket per manager.
- The East Husker Conference Basketball Tournament protocols will be determined at a later date.
- Only those with a ticket will be allowed to pay admission into contests.
- Six feet of separation between parties is encouraged at all activities.
- Families are encouraged to sit together.
- HLHF fans will sit on the west area of the bleachers, visiting fans will be on the east area of the bleachers.
- Jr. High games will be limited to 50% capacity.

Game Procedures

- All spectators and coaches must wear masks covering your nose and mouth.
- Players must wear masks when not warming up or competing.
- Officials are asked to wear masks when entering and exiting the facility. They are not required to wear a mask during the game.
- Masks are required when traveling on a school vehicle.
- Hydration stations are available to fill bottles. Drinking fountains will not be available.
- Players and fans should not congregate on the court following the game.
- Under current conditions, the pep band will not perform, there will be no cheerleaders or dance team members performing.
- Team meals must be distributed outside the facility.
- Team benches will be assigned prior to the games.
- Locker rooms will be assigned upon arrival (cleaned and sanitized)

Restrooms / Concessions

- The concession stand will sell pop, water, pizza, and candy only. You are asked to please eat food in the cafeteria. No food may be brought into the facility by anyone!
- Facilities will be sanitized before and after events.
- Restrooms are located in the main lobby of the school.
- Hydrations stations will be available.

Screening Protocols

- We ask that families screen for COVID-19 symptoms at home.
- Wash hands frequently and properly social distance at least 6-feet if possible.
- If you answer yes to any of the following questions, we ask you not to attend the activity.
 - Have you been in contact with someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
 - Have you tested positive for COVID-19 or are pending results of COVID-19 testing?
 - Do you have the following symptoms? fever over 100.4, dry cough, shortness of breath/difficulty of breathing, loss of taste or smell.
 - Do you have two of the following symptoms: chills, muscle pain, heachache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.

Live Streaming

• You can watch all home varsity girls and boys games as they will be livestreamed. A link will be posted on the HLHF social media pages and sent to opposing schools in advance of the games.

Bowling - JV/Varsity Girls and Boys Matches

- Masks must be worn by everyone in attendance including all coaches and participants when not actively bowling.
- 2 tickets per athlete that is actively participating/coaches (dual meets only in Humphrey).
- Pop/water will be available for sale from the Bowling Alley. No food will be sold.

HLHF Activities Traveling (Practice & Games) - Basketball and Bowling

- Temperature checked prior to traveling.
- Face masks required on bus, vans, and at opposing teams facilities.
- Visiting teams (players, coaches, student managers, bus driver) must complete the HLHF screening document prior to leaving their home school and submit to HLHF personnel upon arrival.
