The Bulldogs have had a very eventful week participating in FFA activities, speech, and preparing for the upcoming spring sports seasons.

On Wednesday, February 25, the speech team traveled to Howells for the East Husker Conference-West Division competition. In serious prose, Jaedyn placed 6th, and Emery finished 4th. Harley placed 5th and Colter placed 4th in persuasive speaking. Lia finished 4th in poetry while Camille placed 3rd. The OID team of Gabe, Natalie, Erin, and Sami finished 3rd, and the team of Colter, Lia, Cejay, Karsen, and Abbey placed 2nd. Gabe placed 4th in Entertainment speaking, while Karsen finished 6th in Informative speaking. Camille placed 5th in Program of Oral Interp. Lia and Cejay were runners up in duet acting, and Keith was the humorous prose runner up. Event champions were as follows. Mariah was the Informative speaking champion. Harley was the Entertainment Speaking champion. Cejay was the champion in Humorous Prose, and Colter earned championship honors in Program of Oral Interp. This year the EHC had a unified division as well. Katie placed 6th with her informative speech. The OID of Archer, Tyler, Blayne, and Xavier placed 4th. Melody finished 3rd with her informative speech. Coming in as runners up were Blayne and Xavier with their duet. Champions in the unified division were Melody and Katie. As a team, the Bulldogs came away with 266 points and the championship plaque.

They also traveled to Lakeview on Saturday, February 28, where they came out as tournament champions. In Informative, Karsen placed 4th and Mariah was 5th. Mac placed 5th and Harley finished 3rd in Persuasive. Harley placed 4th in Entertainment, and Gabe was the champion. The OID of Gabe, Natalie, Erin, and Sami placed 3rd while the OID of Colter, Abbey, Cejay, Lia, and Karsen were event champions. In Duet Acting, Katie and Melody placed 6th, and Lia and Cejay were event champions. In Humorous Prose, Keith finished 3rd, and Cejay was 2nd. Mariah placed 5th, Camille got 4th, and Lia was the runner up in Poetry. Keith placed 6th in Serious. Sami finished 4th in Extemp. Abbey placed 5th, Lia was the runner up, and Camille was the champion in Program of Oral Interp. Their last Saturday speech meet will be this weekend in Creighton, Good Luck!
